SITUATION

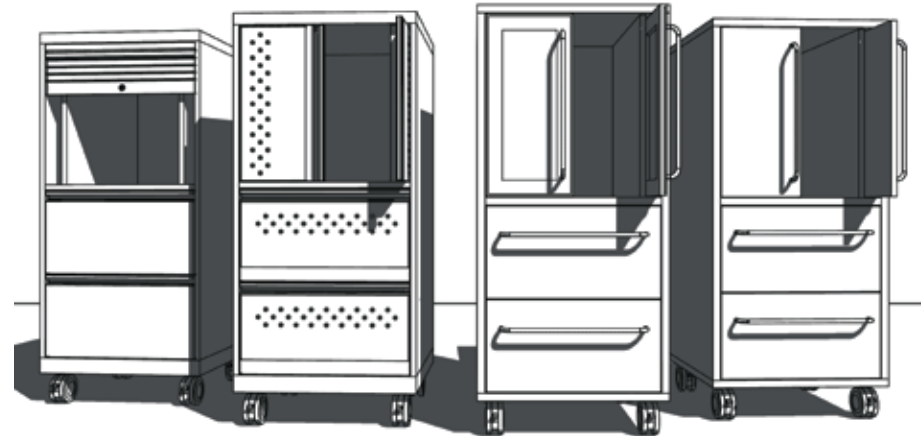
A major tech company was looking for a storage options to fit within the small footprint of their standard offices. The dealer was competing against a Teknion dealer, and in addition to needing a solution, wanted something that would differentiate the product and them as a dealer.

SOLUTION

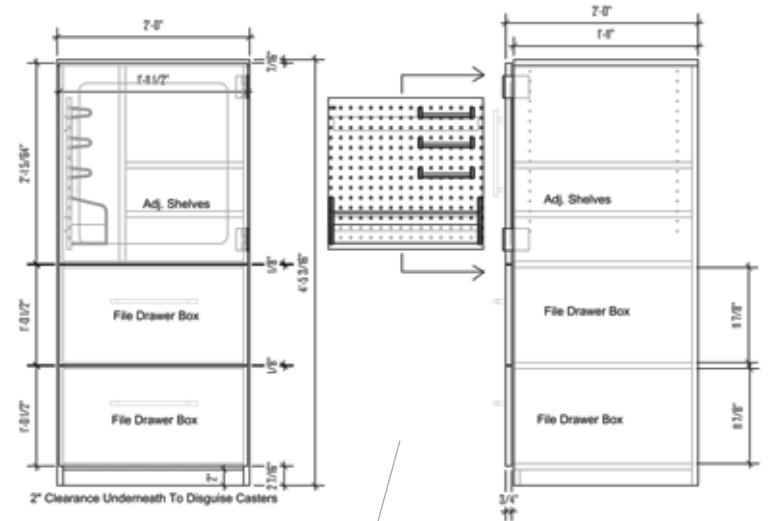
The Vanerum Studio design team went to work to create a series of storage towers, with various options and configurations – Techie, Monk, Gadget and Store-It. Each option provided a package of goodies that allowed the users to store various personal items. Three of the tower options were metal, with the fourth being a totally sustainable offering. The sustainable offering was made of Skyblend Formaldehyde-Free Cores, Greenguard Certified laminates and Sunflower Dakota Burl drawer and door fronts.

RESULT
