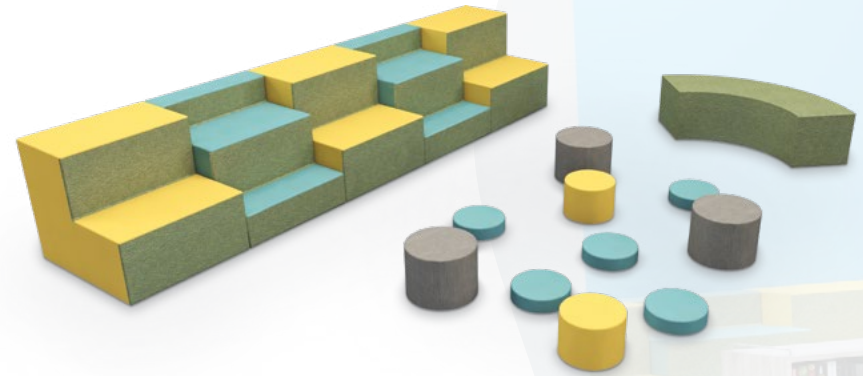




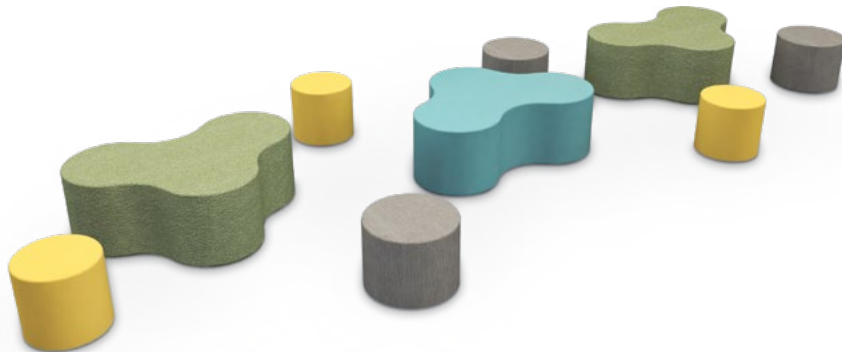




Maker spaces allow students to learn by doing. They can explore topics by playing with materials and creating in real time. This space can also be used for extracurricular activities.

Multiple areas with a variety of soft seating give teachers the option to easily break into learning groups.

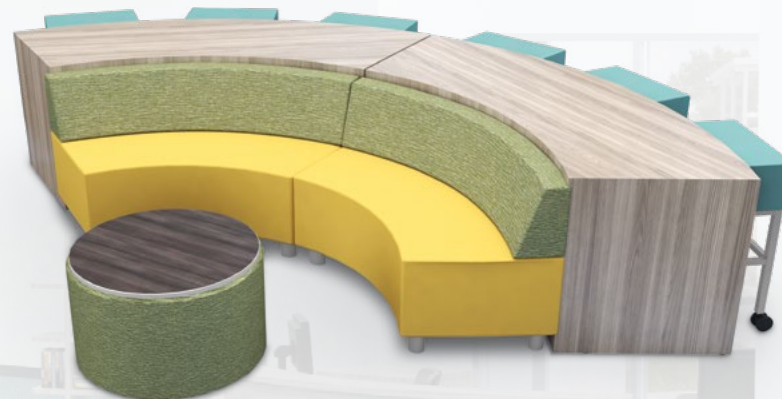


Private, calming spaces such as reading nooks allow young students to recharge and focus. They can be used for solo work or for one-on-one time with their teacher.

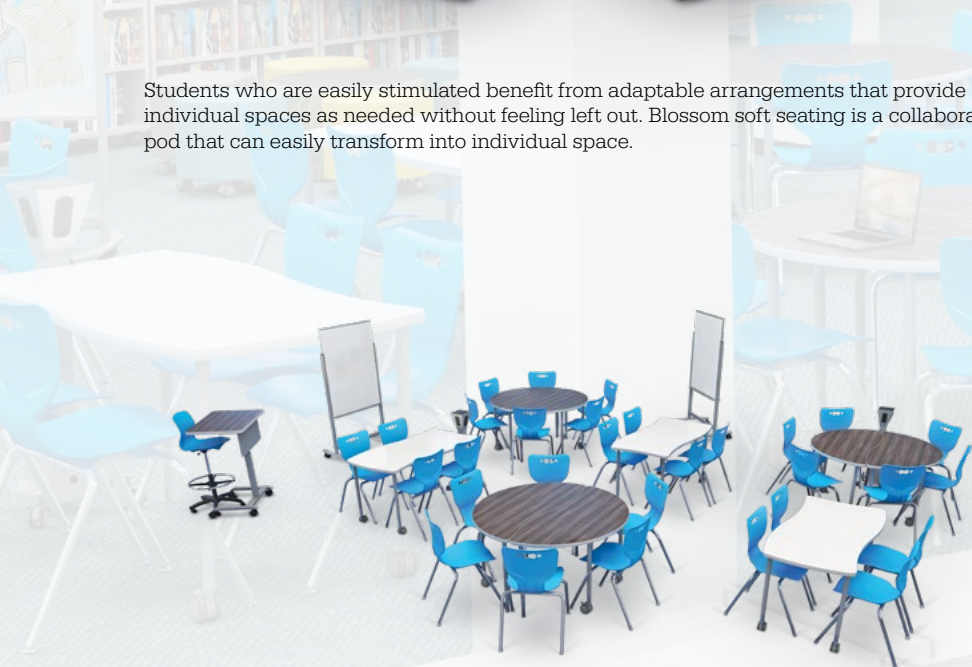

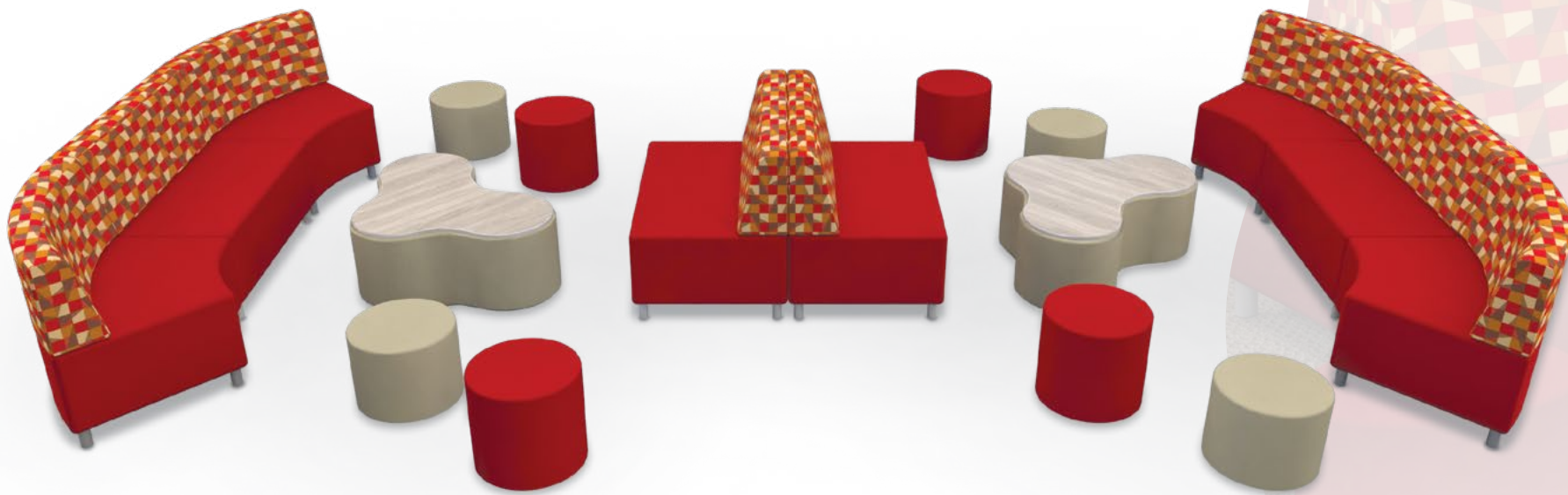




Classroom-style, group collaboration zones allow middle school students to develop valuable social skills while learning from each other.

Media centers with digital meeting areas that mimic office settings build life skills such as teamwork and interoffice communication. Students can practice collaborating in-person or in a hybrid setting.

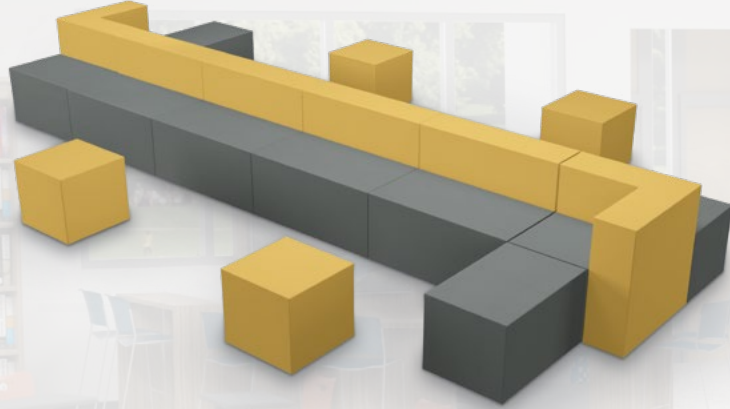


Maker spaces encourage creativity and experimental learning and help develop life skills such as teamwork and inclusivity.
