Media Spaces for Our Youngest Learners

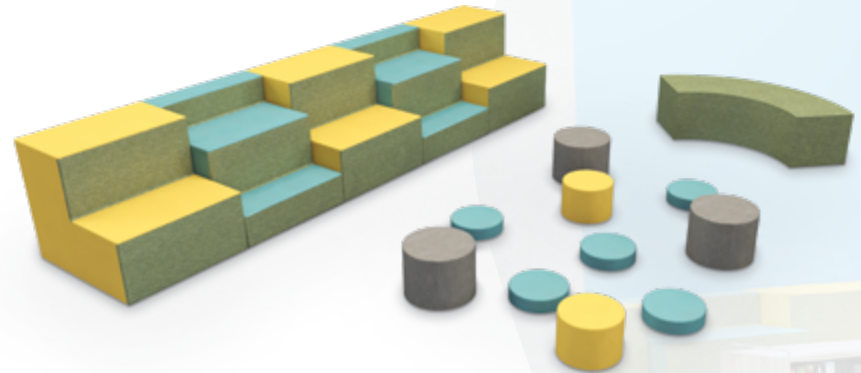

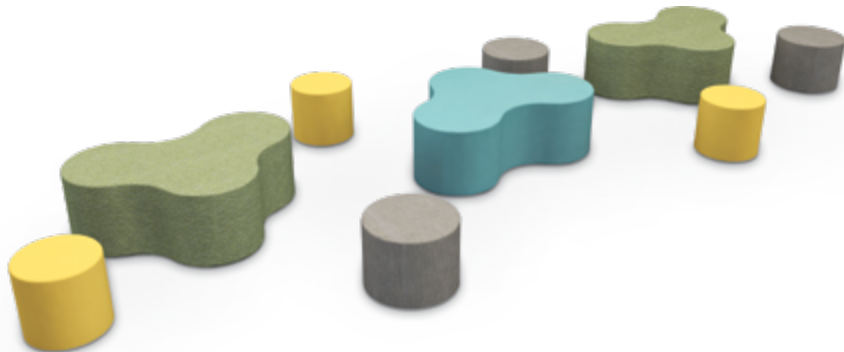




Maker spaces allow students to learn by doing. They can explore topics by playing with materials and creating in real time. This space can also be used for extracurricular activities.



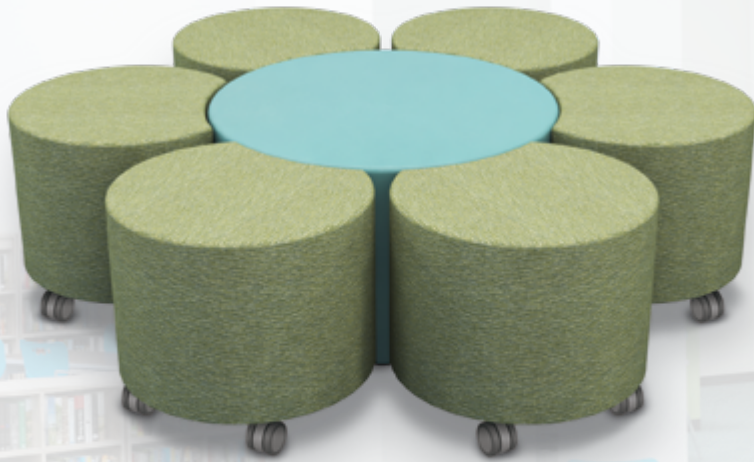
Adaptable, tiered seating and cushions create dynamic spaces for communal reading, performing, and imaginative playtime.



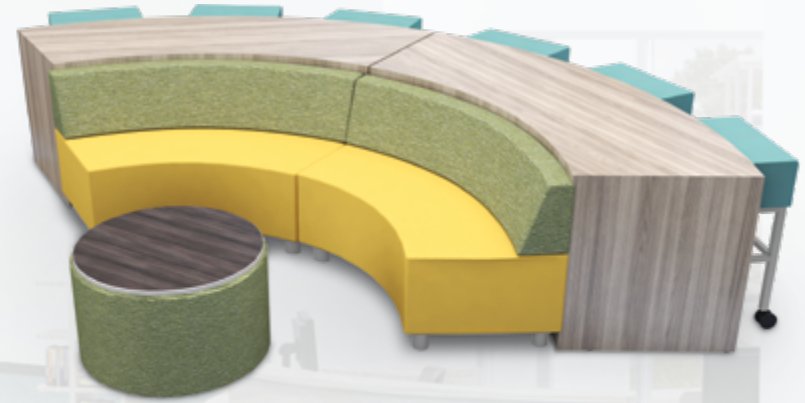
Multiple areas with a variety of soft seating give teachers the option to easily break out into learning groups.



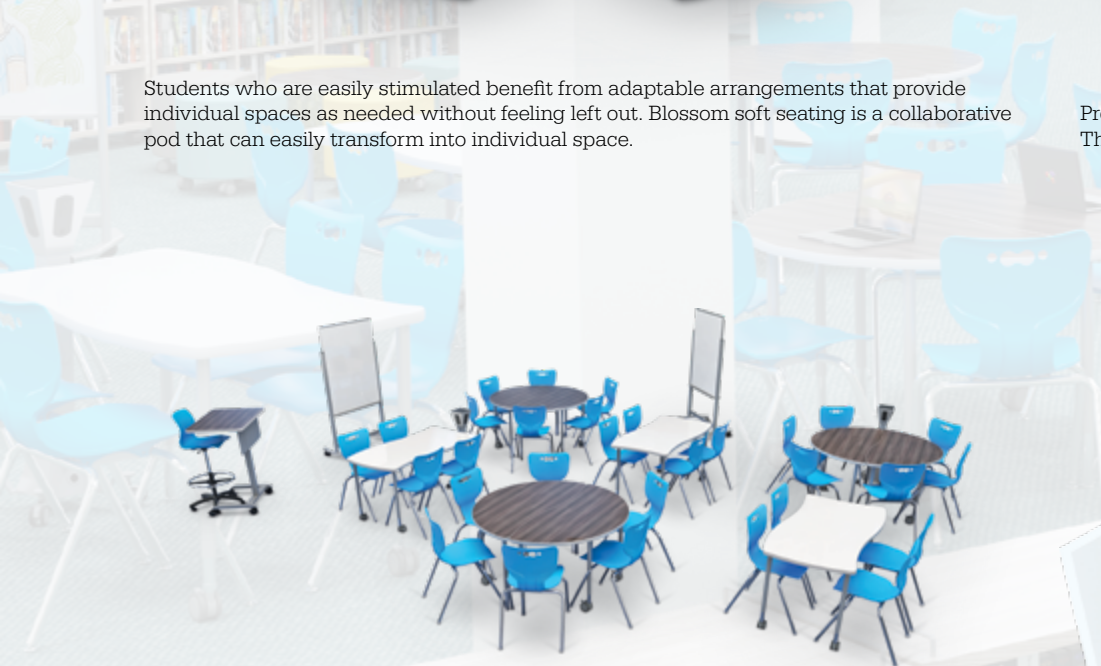
Private, calming spaces such as reading nooks allow young students to recharge and focus. They can be used for solo work or for one-on-one time with their teacher.

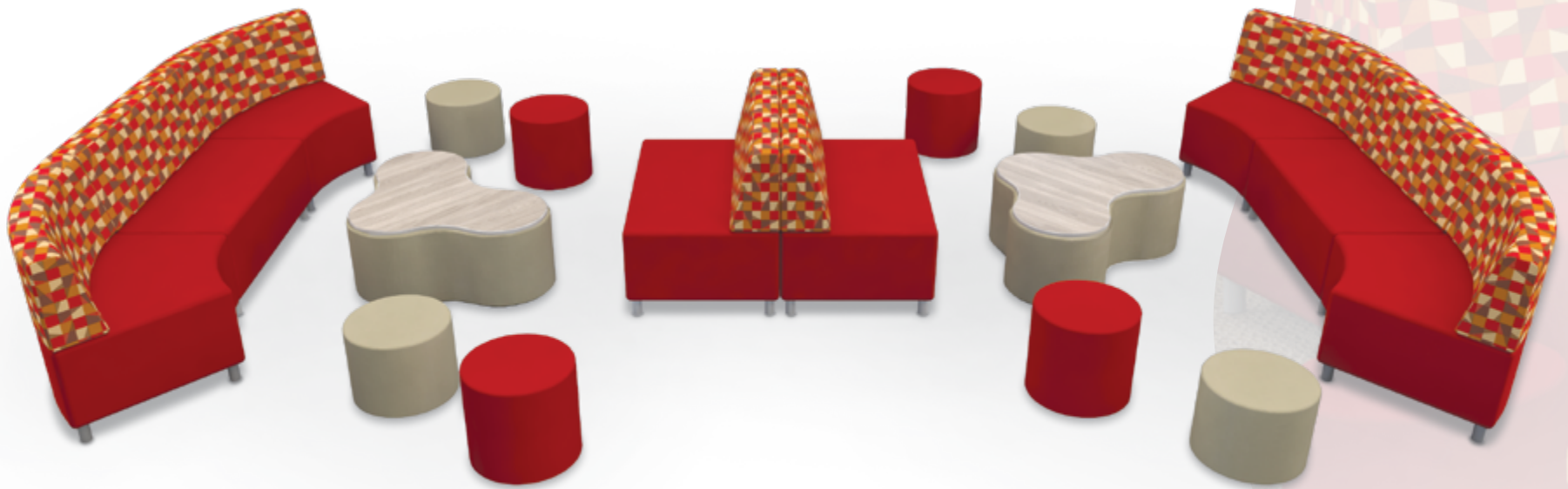




Classroom-style, group collaboration zones allow middle school students to develop valuable social skills while learning from each other.

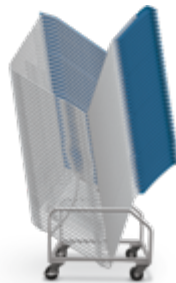

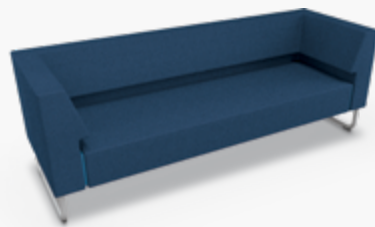

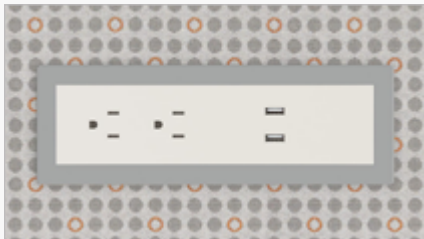
