# A Small Town's Big Transformation

After nearly a century of serving its community in a building dating back to the 1930s, the local high school got a much-needed upgrade. For Sheila Riddle, Superintendent of the Elmore City-Pernell School District, this project was personal. She went to high school in the original building and wanted to honor the community while providing a better facility for its students.

Elmore City-Pernell High School sits on highway as you enter town. Its position intentionally creates a focal point, with a beautifully lit common area greeting locals and visitors. For this centerpiece of the school, Ms. Riddle worked closely with Jill and Eric Bauman of Merrifield Office & School Supply to create a space that was comfortable, functional, and inspiring.

The challenge lay in determining how the common area would be used. Would students be eating there? Meeting? Studying? Socializing? Holding debate and ag tournaments? The answer was: all of the above. Ms. Riddle wanted to foster collaboration and build

a social community inside and outside the school doors. "We didn't want the common area to look like a classroom. The kids needed a space where they could relax, study, or connect with friends," explained Ms. Riddle.




